

The Liturgical Calendar

While the civil calendar orients us to secular life, the liturgical calendar orients us to religious life and, more importantly, helps us to re-live various aspects of the life of Jesus. When we refer to the seasons and feasts on the liturgical calendar, we are not only remembering the historical events that happened in the past, but we are celebrating what continues to happen today. We can do so because the person who is the center of our seasons and feasts is the person of the Risen Christ, who is alive and continues to be revealed to us. In the Catechesis of the Good Shepherd Atrium, the children learn about and work with the liturgical calendar.

God calls us to nurture and develop the gifts He has given us and then generously through Stewardship, return a portion with increase. He doesn't want us to waste or hoard the gifts He has given us.
