

# Rooted presents a beloved tradition in a new light.

This new Catholics

This new 22-episode series guides Catholics through a daily Advent reflection using the Jesse Tree model

traditionally practiced by families. Each seven-minute episode introduces the ancestors of Jesus Christ, shares a Scripture passage, and offers an engaging, practical reflection. Hosted by Dr. Scott Hefelfinger, *Rooted* helps viewers apply the passage and related teachings to each day of Advent, guided by the Church's teaching. Episodes begin on December 3, the First Sunday of Advent, and end on December 24, the Fourth Sunday of Advent.

# LET'S PREPARE - Feast Day of Our Lady of Guadalupe - DECEMBER 12TH


