



Light

In the gospel of Luke (2:29-32), we hear about Simeon, a devout old man who is waiting in the Temple. God revealed that he would not die before seeing the Messiah. When he held the infant Jesus in his arms, he prays, "Now Master, you may let your servant go in peace, according to your word, for my eyes have seen your salvation, which you prepared in sight of all the peoples, a light for revelation to the Gentiles, and glory for your people Israel." In the Catechesis of the Good Shepherd atrium, the children take great delight in knowing Jesus as the light that came into the world. How encouraging for us anxious and troubled souls to hear Luke describe the Blessed Mother Mary in these words, "**But she was greatly troubled at what was said.**" An archangel has visited her. An inconceivable promise has been made to her. Her life has become wildly unpredictable, perhaps more so than any person before or since. This scripture invites us now, this week, to hear the Lord's messenger say to us what he said to Mary, "**Do not be afraid! You have found favor with God**." *Father John Muir* **CLPi**


