

#### Deacon Formation

Like Christ, a deacon is called to serve - and your gifts to the Annual Catholic Appeal, help men in discernment and formation to prepare for that call to serve! The Diocese of Great Falls-Billings currently has two cohorts (groups) of men in formation to become permanent deacons. They are led by our Director of Deacon Formation, Deacon Pete Woelkers. Each cohort meets one weekend a month and, God willing, after four years of formation go on to be ordained. Ordination for six of the men in formation is planned for June 8, 2024, in Billings, MT and we will be sharing video interviews with each for you to get to know them better.
